When the industry investigated the need to make changes in the wake of high profile injuries, it utilized groundwork laid down by the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation and The Jockey Club as a result of their initial Welfare and Safety of the Racehorse Summit. The industry organization's committees formed in 2008 both utilized and gave further prominence to committee work growing out of the Summit and involving such matters as shoeing safety and hoof care, standardized testing of trainers, ongoing education for licensees, and indicators of soundness and durability. At the same time, Grayson-Jockey Club has continued with its core mission of evaluating and funding the best research projects available at universities across North America and beyond.

A year-round clinic at Belmont and six-month seasonal clinic at Saratoga provide primary, preventive and urgent health care services, free of charge to all those who work with the horses. B.E.S.T. also provides assistance, advice and training on financial, vocational, educational and legal matters.

B.E.S.T. also assists with disability benefits and workers' compensation claims and offers on-site counseling by licensed therapists who address anger management, domestic violence, family and mental health issues, as well as alcohol and substance abuse counseling.
