Advanced Horsemanship

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2006 WSS Issues/Recommendations:

- Need for Continuing Education for those who work with horses
- Lack of education/consistency/standardizations
- Decline of horsemanship

2008 WSS Recommendation:

- Education Committee Recommendation – improve horse handling of frontline employees by developing continuing education programs for trainers



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Continuing Education Requirements

Veterinarian – 36 hrs / 2 yrs

Steward – 16 hrs / 2 yrs

Nurse – 14 hrs / 1 yr

Massage Therapist – 24 hrs / 2 yrs

Athletic Trainer – 60 hrs / 3 yrs

Nail Technician – 5 hrs / 1 yr



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ARCI Model Rule:

ARCI-008-020 Trainers

A. Eligibility

(4) Beginning no later than January 1, 2010, in order to maintain a current license, trainers must complete at least four (4) hours per calendar year of continuing education courses approved by the ARCI or the commission in that jurisdiction

Current Programs:

Indiana – by rule

Washington – voluntary

Colorado – rule on books

CHRB – developed programming

South Dakota – rule passed, then repealed
